ABOUT COMMITTEES



ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL COUNCIL (ECOSOC)

Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC), one of the six principal organs of the United Nations (UN), responsible for the direction and coordination of the economic, social, humanitarian, and cultural activities carried out by the UN. It is the UN's largest and most complex subsidiary body. No. of countries max: 48 countries 3 chairpersons.



UNITED NATIONS HUMAN RIGHTS COUNCIL (UNHRC)

The UN Human Rights Council (UNHRC) is a United Nations body responsible for promoting and protecting human rights worldwide. The UNHRC addresses human rights violations, makes recommendations, and provides a platform for dialogue on human rights issues. No. of countries max: 47 countries 3 chairpersons.



COMMISSION ON THE STATUS OF WOMEN (CSW)

The Commission on the Status of Women (CSW) is the principal global intergovernmental body exclusively dedicated to the promotion of gender equality, the rights and the empowerment of women. The CSW is instrumental in promoting women's and girls' rights. No. of countries max: 45 countries 3 chairperson



ALL INDIA POLITICAL PARTIES MEET (AIPPM)

It is a committee simulation where participants represent different political parties and debate on a specific agenda. No. of parties: 40 max 2 chairpersons.



UNITED NATIONS SECURITY COUNCIL (UNSC)

The Security Council has primary responsibility for the maintenance of international peace and security. It has 15 Members, and each Member has one vote. It calls upon the parties to a dispute to settle it by peaceful means and recommends methods of adjustment. No. of countries max: 20 countries Double Delegation 2 chairperson.



UNITED NATIONS GENERAL ASSEMBLY (UNGA)

UNGA stands for the United Nations General Assembly. It's a forum where all 193 UN Member States can discuss and address a wide range of international issues. No. of countries max: 54 countries 3 chairpersons.



INTERNATIONAL PRESS (IPP/IPC)

The International Press Corps (IPC) is a committee that simulates a real-world media organization. Delegates in the IPC act as journalists, photographers, and media personnel, covering the proceedings of other MUN committees and reporting on them through various media formats. No. of allots: 20, 2 chairpersons.
